LABOR MARKET

DIA DNIPROPETROVSK INVESTMENT AGENCY

Dnipropetrovsk region is one of the main labor markets in Ukraine. The region is home to 1.3 million economically active people (8.9% of the Ukrainian total).

The region has one of the highest employment rates among the working-age population - 64.3%.

The average salary in 2023 is \$485.

Since the beginning of the full-scale invasion, the region has become a center for providing assistance to IDPs, relocating businesses and higher education and research institutions from southeastern Ukraine.

About 500,000 IDPs are registered here, 52% of whom are of working age. The cities of Dnipro and Kryvyi Rih have the largest number of IDPs.

Social guarantees of enterprises:

Minimum wage/pension:

- in the monthly amount \$218.8;
- hourly \$1.3;
- minimum pension \$64.7.

Annual vacation:

- basic paid vacation 24 days;
- additional unpaid vacation 14 calendar days.

Working hours:

- the working week is 5 days;
- working day 8 hours;
- retirement age 60-65 years (depending on length of service).

Payment of sick leave:

- up to 3 years of service up to 50% of the salary is paid;
- from 3 to 5 years 60% of the salary;
- from 5 to 8 years 70% of the salary;
- from 8 years 100% of the salary.

Payment for business trips:

- The maximum amount of per diem for business trips in Ukraine is \$8.2;
- the maximum amount of per diem for business trips abroad is \$56-80.

Payroll taxes:

- unified social tax 22%;
- personal income tax 18%;
- military duty 5%.





Dnipropetrovsk region annually trains specialists for various industries

Educational institutions are open to cooperation with employers to train personnel in the relevant fields.

They operate in the region:

- 21 higher education institutions with more than 81 thousand students.
- In 2023, about 15.4 thousand specialists graduated.
- 41 institutions of professional higher education (vocational colleges and technical schools) with 40.7 thousand students.
- In 2023, more than 10.6 thousand specialists graduated.
- 57 vocational schools with 19.0 thousand students.
- In 2023, 10.2 thousand skilled workers graduated.

The region trains personnel in many educational areas, including using the dual education system to provide future employees with practical experience at the enterprise.

Each year, the region's educational institutions train more than **36,200 specialists** of various qualifications and backgrounds.

The educational process is carried out by 5189 research and teaching staff and 899 pedagogical staff, including 957 doctors of sciences; 772 professors; 3091 candidates of sciences; 2397 associate professors. The total number of employees of higher education institutions is 12588 people.

Currently, 4 higher education institutions and 6 institutions of higher education in the region will also provide educational services, with a total of more than 300 teachers from Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
